Getting Started:

1. Who is the wisest person you've ever known? How do you think he/she obtained such wisdom?

Discussion Questions:

2. How would you define wisdom?
3. In verse 17, Paul writes, “I pray that the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of glory, may give you a spirit of wisdom and revelation as you come to know him.” What is the difference between wisdom and revelation?
4. Why do we need wisdom? Is there a difference between God's wisdom and man's wisdom?
5. In what ways would you like to know God more fully?
6. From Pastor Dan's sermon we learn that God's wisdom comes from reading the bible, praying or listening to God, and through others. In which of these ways (or another way that may not be listed) have you been most powerfully directed by God in your life?
7. In what areas in your life have you seen success or fruit because of discipline? In what areas of your spiritual walk could you use more discipline?
8. How have you seen your life or other people's lives around you grow busier and busier? Do you ever feel like you are missing out on something because of this fast pace of life?
9. What are ways in which you can slow down? What are ways (big or small) that you can begin to seek solitude and be with God?
